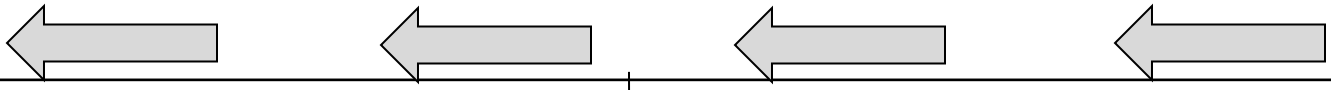

Community Circle – Session Order

Scoring begins as soon as classes turn the corner to gym

<p>1. Call to Enter Classes line up in hallway to gym in class ascending order (501, 502, 503). First class should be lined up behind auditorium backstage door. All classes must remain quiet in 2 straight lines.</p>	<p>2. Entering Community Circle (hallway to gym on drum beat) Follow arrow pattern indicated on map to assigned seating sides. Walk only on burgundy painted floor. Once class per side of the gym. Remain standing Can spread out in 1-2 rows along the black line</p>	<p>3. Call to Order Wait standing at assigned seating areas for signal of ceremony leader. Spread out in the burgundy painted are along the line</p>
<p>4. School Song Sung together in unison as a community. Individual classes may volunteer to sing.</p>	<p>5. Call to Take Seats Wait for signal of ceremony master Classes sit in unison</p>	<p>6. No Place for Hate Call One student representative from each class must be preselected to lead their class. Each class presents individually</p>
<p>7. Roll Call Ceremony Leader will call each class individually with the following call and respond: Leader: “We welcome class ____ to the Community Circle” Community responds: “Welcome class ____”</p>	<p>8. Best Better Best Ceremony Leader introduces one teacher at a time. Each class teacher leads their own class. Classes take turns</p>	<p>8. Open Circle Ceremony Leader will announce topic for open share by teachers. Teachers come to the middle of the community circle room on a first come basis and share to entire community. Topics may include: class color, circle, grade band and code, presentation of flags or lead class in calls</p>
<p>9. Welcome Ceremony lead will begin opening remarks Ceremony leads will include admin and visitors</p>	<p>10. Singspiration (will begin in November) Student team leads community in song and dance. Student representatives are invited to middle of circle to perform.</p>	<p>11. Instructional Role Call (will begin in March) See calendar for start date. Not included in initial meetings. Led by volunteer staff or admin Utilizes current units of study in math and ELA</p>
<p>12. Leaving Community Circle (wait for ceremony master lead) Call to stand by class Call to turn by class Call to walk: follow arrow pattern indicated on map to exit (same pattern as entry)</p>	<p>Rubric for scoring:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Knowledgeable of call lyrics: based on % of students 2. Understanding of beat or rhythm of call: based on % of students 3. Call presented collectively: based on % of students 4. Class follows movement directions for standing, sitting, walking in burgundy painted area 5. Class follows rules of hallway standing (straight lines, looking forward, quiet and waiting). 6. Punctuality and line up order. 7. Accessorizing: classes add individual touches to movement, performing and logistics which all students follow. Scores based on creativity and percent of students following. <p>Awarding Points: 80%- ceremony leads, 20%-admin or guests, 1-2 winners per community circle session</p>

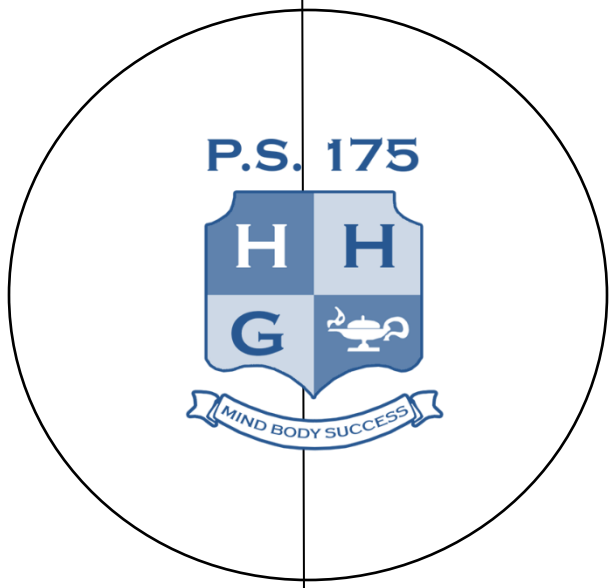
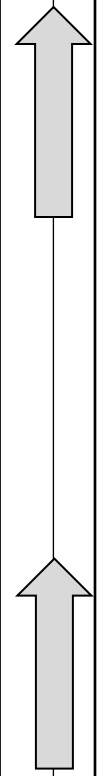
